



## **NOTICE UNDER RULE 14 – ACCESS TO INFORMATION PROCEDURE RULES URGENT NON-KEY DECISION EXCLUSION OF CALL-IN**

### **MATTER TO WHICH THIS NOTICE RELATES:**

**Non-key decision:- Local Government Re-organisation – interim plan -  
To agree to submit an interim plan to Government by 21 March 2025**

### **NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT:**

The Leader of South Holland District Council has made a non-key decision in respect of the above matter under Rule 14 of the Access to Information Procedure Rules.

Rule 14 allows a non-key decision to be taken without call-in where it is considered that any delay likely to be caused by the call-in process would seriously prejudice the Council's or the public's interest.

In respect of the decision, the subject of this notice, any delay likely to be caused by the call-in process would seriously prejudice the Council's or the public's interest because of the requirement to submit the Local Government Re-organisation interim plan to Government by the 21 March 2025 deadline.

In accordance with Rule 14 of the Access to Information Procedure Rules:

- the Chairman of the Performance Monitoring Panel has agreed both that the decision is reasonable in all the circumstances and that the decision may be taken urgently; and
- as the decision is urgent, the call-in procedure will not apply and the decision will take effect immediately; and
- a report will be submitted to the next available meeting of full Council indicating the reasons for the urgency.
