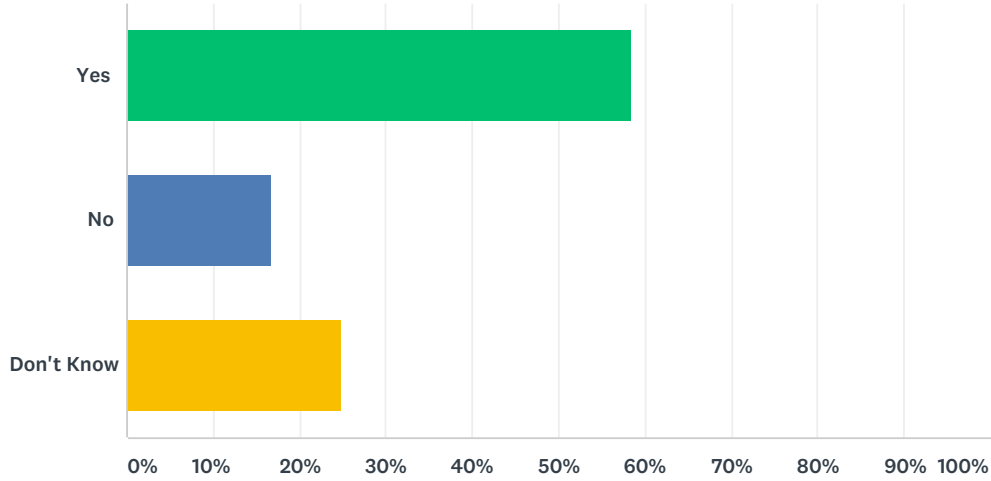


### Q1 Do you agree that we should keep the main characteristics of the current Council Tax Support scheme for the next financial year to provide continuity?

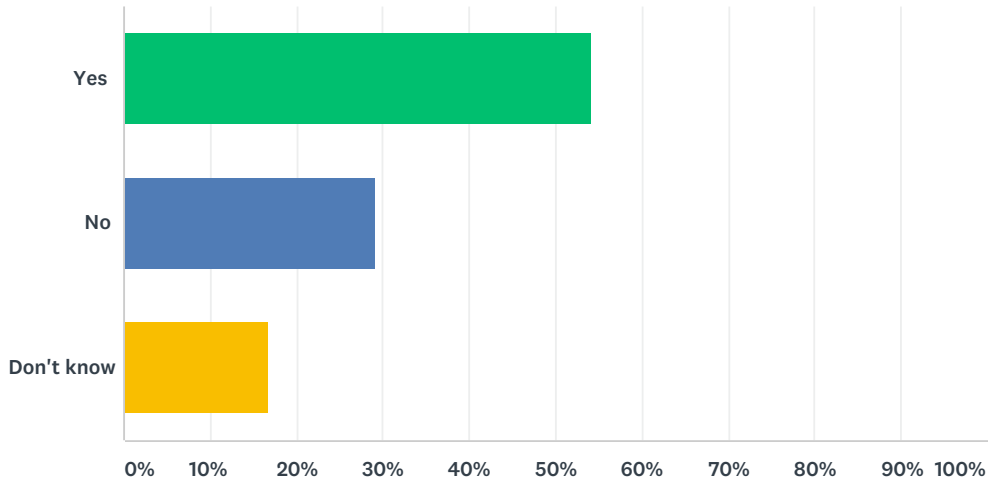

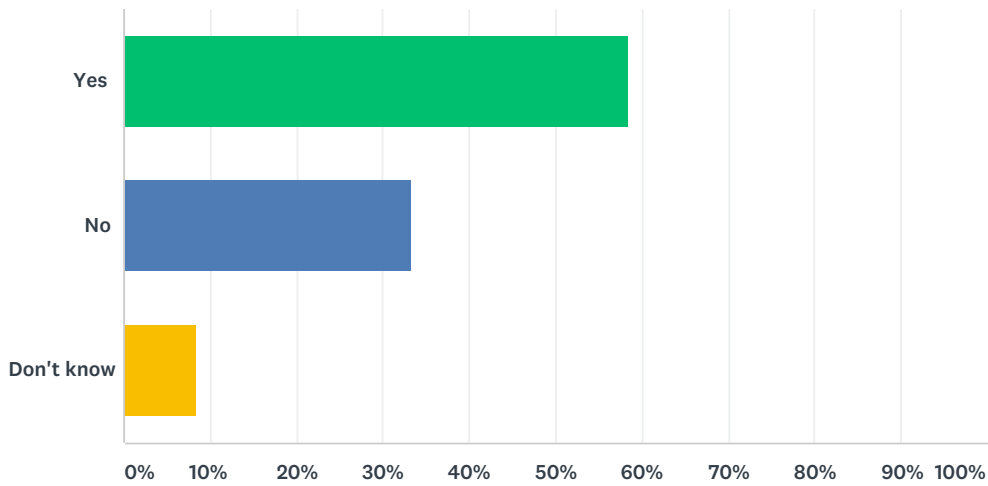

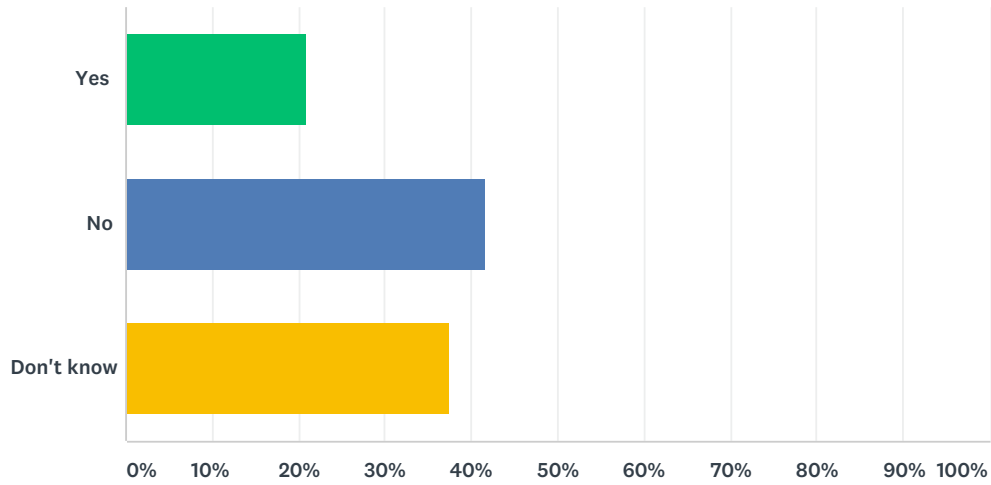
