### **NOTICE OF PROPOSALS**

#### **SOUTH HOLLAND DISTRICT COUNCIL (OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES) (CIVIL ENFORCEMENT) (AMENDMENT NO. 2) ORDER 2019**

Notice is hereby given that South District Council (“the Council”), in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, and the Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and all other enabling powers, proposes to make the South Holland District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement) (Amendment No. 2) Order 2019 (“the Amending Order”).

The effect of the Amending Order, if made, will be to amend the South Holland District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement) Order 2012 so as to restrict vehicles other than electric vehicles from parking in electric vehicle charging bays, and to require electric vehicles to move out of electric vehicle charging bays once they have been charged.

The amendment is required because the Council wishes to provide electric vehicle charging bays within the following car parks and needs to ensure that such bays are used appropriately:

- Vine Street
- Victoria Street
- Fishpond Lane

Full details of the proposals are in the draft Amending Order which, together with a statement of the Council’s reason for proposing to make the Amending Order, may be examined at the Council’s Offices at Priory Road, Spalding PE11 2XE during normal office hours.

If you wish to submit an objection or other representation relating to the proposed Amending Order you must specify the grounds of your objection or representation and send it in writing to arrive no later than 5pm on 11<sup>th</sup> December 2018 to Jacqui Berridge, Council Offices, Priory Road, Spalding Lincs PE11 2XE.
