A Review is sought on the grounds of the licensing objectives: 1) The Prevention of Crime and Disorder 2) Public Safety 3) The Prevention of Public Nuisance 4) The Protection of Children from Harm

The Premises are licensed for: The Sale by Retail of Alcohol for consumption off the premises.

DESCRIPTION OF REVIEW

Lincolnshire Police have obtained evidence which indicates that the management of the premises have been operating in such a manner as to undermine the licensing objectives by the keeping of smuggled goods on the premises. There has also been non-compliance found in relation to the conditions on the premises licence.

Other Persons or Responsible Authorities may make a representation in writing to South Holland District Council Offices within 28 days. Closing date for representations is **11th December 2018**.

It is an offence liable on summary conviction to a fine up to level 5 (£5,000) on the standard scale to knowingly or recklessly make a false statement in connection with the application.
