A Review is sought on the grounds of the licensing objectives: 1) The Prevention of Crime and Disorder 2) Public Safety 3) The Prevention of Public Nuisance 4) The Protection of Children from Harm

The Premises are licensed for: The Sale by Retail of Alcohol (On and off) the premises/ Regulated Entertainment and Late Night Refreshment

DESCRIPTION OF REVIEW

Lincolnshire Police have received intelligence which indicates that the premises have been operating in a manner to undermine the above licensing objectives. Despite repeated visits and a stepped approach taken by Lincolnshire Police which resulted in a review of the premises in 2018, further intelligence has been received that regular drug activity is taking place within the premises. There are also breaches of the premises licence conditions.

Other Persons or Responsible Authorities may make representation in writing to South Holland District Council Offices within 28 days. Closing date for representations is **16th September 2019**.

It is an offence liable on summary conviction to a fine up to level 5 (£5,000) on the standard scale to knowingly or recklessly make a false statement in connection with the application.
