Lincolnshire Police have acquired evidence in relation to selling food not as requested or expected under section 14 of the Food Safety Act 1990, employing an illegal worker under section 21 of the Immigration, Asylum and Nationality Act 2006, as amended by section 35 of the Immigration Act 2016 and non-compliance with the annex two conditions on their premises licence, specifically CCTV.

Other Persons or Responsible Authorities may make representation in writing to South Holland District Council Offices within 28 days. Closing date for representations is **26 FEBRUARY 2020**
