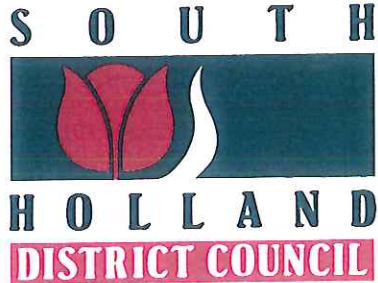

Annex 1 - Mandatory Conditions

1. No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence.
2. No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.
3. Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.
4. (1) The premises licence holder or club premises certificate holder must ensure that an age verification policy is adopted in respect of the premises in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol.
(2) The designated premises supervisor in relation to the premises licence must ensure that the supply of alcohol at the premises is carried on in accordance with the age verification policy.
(3) The policy must require individuals who appear to the responsible person to be under 18 years of age (or such older age as may be specified in the policy) to produce on request, before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and either-
 - (a) a holographic mark, or
 - (b) an ultraviolet feature.
5. A relevant person shall ensure that no alcohol is sold or supplied for consumption on or off the premises for a price which is less than the permitted price.
6. In this condition:
 - (a) "Permitted price" is the price found by applying the formula $P = D + (D \times V)$, where:
 - (i) P is the permitted price
 - (ii) D is the amount of duty chargeable in relation to the alcohol as if the duty were charged on the date of the sale or supply of the alcohol, and
 - (iii) V is the rate of value added tax chargeable in relation to the alcohol as if the value added tax were charged on the date of the sale or supply of the alcohol
 - (b) "Duty" is to be construed in accordance with the Alcoholic Liquor Duties Act 1979
 - (c) "Relevant person" means, in relation to premises in respect of which there is in force a premises licence:
 - (i) the holder of the Premises Licence
 - (ii) the Designated Premises supervisor (if any) in respect of such a licence, or
 - (iii) the Personal Licence Holder who makes or authorises a supply of alcohol under such a licence
 - (d) "relevant person" means, in relation to premises in respect of which there is in force a Club Premises Certificate, any member or officer of the club present on the premises in a capacity which enables the member or officer to prevent the supply in question; and
 - (e) "value added tax" means value added tax charged in accordance with the Value Added Tax Act 1994.

7. Where the permitted price would not be a whole number of pennies, the permitted price shall be taken to be the price rounded up to the nearest penny.
8. Where the permitted price on a day ("the first day") would be different from the permitted price on the next day ("the second day") as a result of a change to the rate of duty or value added tax, the permitted price which would apply on the first day applies to sales or supplies of alcohol which take place before the expiry of the period of 14 days beginning on the second day.

Annex 2 - Conditions consistent with the operating schedule

General

The prevention of crime and disorder

1. A CCTV system used on the premises shall be registered in accordance with the Data Protection Act and relevant codes of practice.
2. There shall be sufficient cameras to cover those areas that are not easily supervised from the counter with one of the cameras providing a front facial view of customers upon entry.
3. The system shall be capable of continuously recording and copies of such recordings shall be kept for a period of not less than 28 days and handed to a Police Constable or authorised person upon request.
4. The premises licence holder shall be responsible for the operation of the system and shall ensure that it is maintained in accordance with these codes of practice.
5. The system shall be maintained in working order.
6. Recordings shall be made of each trading period conducted at the premises.

7. 'Premises Age Verification Policy' - This policy applies in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol on these premises.
 - a) For this policy, the responsible person is one of the following:-
 - The holder of the Premises Licence.
 - The Designated Premises Supervisor.
 - A person aged 18 or over who is authorised to allow the sale or supply of alcohol by an under 18 year old.
 - b) Staff serving alcohol on the premises shall require any individuals who appear to the responsible person to be under the age of 21 years of age, to produce on request, before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and a holographic

mark.

c) Examples of appropriate identification include:-

- A photo card driving licence
- A passport
- A proof of age card bearing the PASS hologram.

d) The premises licence holder shall ensure that staff are made aware of the existence and content of this policy and shall ensure that the staff receive regular training sufficient and appropriate to the implementation and operation of this policy.

Annex 3 - Conditions attached after a hearing by the licensing authority

1. The premises shall display a sign reminding customers to park legally and be mindful of the location near to a zebra crossing

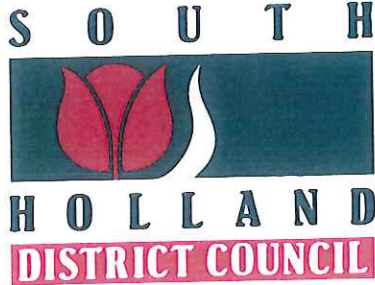
