ANNEX 1 - MANDATORY CONDITIONS**a) Licensing Act 2003 Mandatory Conditions**

1. No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or
2. No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.
3. Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.
4. (1) The premises licence holder or club premises certificate holder must ensure that an age verification policy is adopted in respect of the premises in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol.
(2) The designated premises supervisor in relation to the premises licence must ensure that the supply of alcohol at the premises is carried on in accordance with the age verification policy.
(3) The policy must require individuals who appear to the responsible person to be under 18 years of age (or such older age as may be specified in the policy) to produce on request, before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and either-
 - (a) a holographic mark, or
 - (b) an ultraviolet feature.
5. A relevant person shall ensure that no alcohol is sold or supplied for consumption on or off the premises for a price which is less than the permitted price.
6. In this condition:
 - (a) "permitted price" is the price found by applying the formula $P = D + (D \times V)$, where:
 - (i) P is the permitted price
 - (ii) D is the amount of duty chargeable in relation to the alcohol as if the duty were charged on the date of the sale or supply of the alcohol, and
 - (iii) V is the rate of value added tax chargeable in relation to the alcohol as if the value added tax were charged on the date of the sale or supply of the alcohol
 - (b) "duty" is to be construed in accordance with the Alcoholic Liquor Duties Act 1979
 - (c) "relevant person" means, in relation to premises in respect of which there is in force a premises licence:
 - (i) the holder of the Premises Licence
 - (ii) the Designated Premises supervisor (if any) in respect of such a licence, or
 - (iii) the Personal Licence Holder who makes or authorises a supply of alcohol under such a licence
 - (d) "relevant person" means, in relation to premises in respect of which there is in force a Club Premises Certificate, any member or officer of the club present on the premises in a capacity which enables the member or officer to prevent the supply in question; and

(e) "value added tax" means value added tax charged in accordance with the Value Added Tax Act 1994.

7. Where the permitted price would not be a whole number of pennies, the permitted price shall be taken to be the price rounded up to the nearest penny.
8. Where the permitted price on a day ("the first day") would be different from the permitted price on the next day ("the second day") as a result of a change to the rate of duty or value added tax, the permitted price which would apply on the first day applies to sales or supplies of alcohol which take place before the expiry of the period of 14 days beginning on the second day.

ANNEX 2 - CONDITIONS CONSISTENT WITH THE OPERATING SCHEDULE

Prevention of Crime & Disorder

1. The Premises will be secured against unauthorised access when closed.
2. Alarm system will be in operation together with CCTV.
3. Age verification systems will be in operation.
4. Incident and refusals log will be in operation.
5. Premises Licence holder will work closely with all responsible authorities.
6. All staff will be aware of their responsibilities regarding the sale of alcohol.
7. Persons deemed to be drunk will not be supplied with alcohol.

Public Safety

1. The premises will conform to all statutory Health and Safety and Hygiene Regulations.

Prevention of Public Nuisance

1. Customers will not be allowed to consume alcohol in or directly outside the premises or congregate near it.

Protection of Children from Harm

1. Age verification systems will be in operation (Challenge 21).
2. Refusals log will be kept and available for inspection.

ANNEX 3 - CONDITIONS ATTACHED AFTER A HEARING BY THE LICENSING AUTHORITY on 15th December 2010

1. All staff shall be trained in the sale of alcohol and will undertake regular Continuous Professional Development.
2. CCTV shall be installed which will conform to the specification of Lincolnshire Police and be agreed with Lincolnshire Police.


CONDITIONS ATTACHED AFTER A HEARING BY THE LICENSING AUTHORITY on 9th December 2011

1. The Designated Premises Supervisor should be a permanent full-time member of the branch staff and able to perform the required duties as such not being required to spend any time in other locations.
2. In the absence of the Designated Premises Supervisor there should be a Personal Licence Holder present on the premises at all times the business is open for the sale of alcohol.
3. The premises shall not trade unless at least two permanent employees, suitably trained to the standards set out by the franchisor in its training package are employed.
4. An incident record shall be kept at the premises of all occasions when a challenge to serve for either under age or drunkenness was made. This record shall be to the satisfaction of the local Police Licensing Officer and available for inspection on request.
5. The premises shall operate an Under Age Policy to the standards of Challenge Under 25.
