

Anti-Social Behaviour Enforcement Action taken by South Holland District Council in Partnership with Lincolnshire Police

South Holland District Council's Community Safety and Enforcement Team, work in partnership with Lincolnshire Police, Housing Associations, and other agencies to tackle Anti-Social Behaviour (ASB). Officers follow the guidance set out in the Countywide procedures for tackling ASB in Lincolnshire, which details the tools and powers brought in by the Anti-Social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014. An incremental approach is used to give advice and encourage people to stop the ASB before considering more formal (legal) methods. People are provided with support, guidance and signposting to other organisations who may be able to help, where applicable. The process differs for adults and young people, below is an example of the approach.
